### The courses under Pudhuvazhvu Thittam sponsored by Govt. of Tamilnadu

HIET conducted two programmes viz., Four Wheeler Mechanics, two and three Wheeler Mechanics under the project Puduvazhu Thittam for the poor people in and around Padappai Village. This project was initiated by Govt. of Tamil Nadu. Pudhu Vaazhvu Project is an empowerment and poverty alleviation Programme, being implemented with World Bank assistance for a period of 6 years. The Project covers 2,509 Village Panchayats in 70 backward Blocks in 16 districts. 43 students have successfully completed the training and many of them have got employment in Automobile servicing centres.

HIET offers refrigeration and air conditioning course for final year Mechanical Engineering students of our institute both theoretical and practical to meet the needs of air conditioning professionals, delivering industry recognized qualifications. Refrigeration and air conditioning course covers installation, commissioning & maintenance, Design principles, Pipework & brazing and refrigeration electrical connections.

HIET offers plumbing training also for students to develop their skills.
